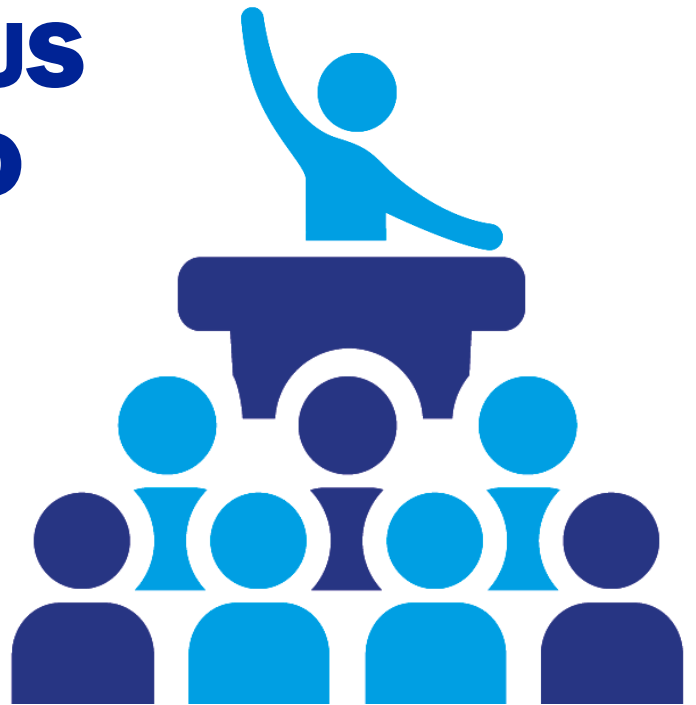


CAN YOU HELP US KEEP TRAFFORD BLUE?

Working with the Associations, Group, Wards and Candidates in Trafford you will be pivotal in turning strategy into effective Ward level campaigning for the 2018 Local Elections. This is initially a role through to the 2018 local elections, with a review in May 2017.

Based in two Association's offices, it requires a flexible approach to both timing and location of activities.

This job is the equivalent of 3 days/week, spread across weekdays, evenings and weekends.

It requires you to be able to prioritise/manage your time to reflect the unpredictability and timings of typical Ward/ Candidate campaign activity.

Salary indication £13.5k p.a.

The job - reporting to the Chairman of ASWCA, is to:

- Lead, at Ward level, the Trafford 2018 LE Strategy implementation.
- Work with Candidates, Councillors and Wards to develop and organise the detailed campaign plans, skills and activist support to hold and win seats.
- Oversee the effectiveness of the campaign, the quality of Votesource data collection and analysis; and working with the Elections Committee reporting progress; recommending remedial action as necessary.
- Show flexibility of thought and the ability to recognise changing circumstances and develop responses.
