■ The long-awaited start date of Broadheath's new community centre, nursery and restaurant has been confirmed as April 2017.

The new development will be sited next to Broadheath Primary School, and is expected to be completed before Christmas, meaning residents will be able to enjoy the facilities over the festive period. Cllr Stephen Anstee lobbied the Council hard to see it do all it can to secure the promised funding from the developers of the Stamford Brook estate, allowing the project build to commence. Cllr Anstee said "Years of work has gone into this project by some very committed people, and I am pleased to have been able to play my part in unlocking the final hurdle to get this project off the ground."

## Action on crossing the A56




## Protecting our Education System
